SV03: Obsidian Flames FAQ Addendum

POKEMON ABILITIES

DOUBLE TYPE (Scovillain - SV:Obsidian Flames)

- Q. Does a Pokemon with multiple types such as Scovillain with the "Double Type" Ability count for two different types of Pokemon for Toxtricity's "Loud Mix" attack?
- {A. Yes, Loud Mix checks for the number of types of Pokemon on your Bench, not how many Pokemon there are.}

PRECIOUS GIFT (Togekiss - SV:Obsidian Flames)

- Q. Do I have to attack in order to use Togekiss' "Precious Gift" Ability?
- {A. No, the "(after you attack)" text is just a reminder that your attack happens before the end of your turn. You can still use Precious Gift even if you don't attack.}
- Q. Do I use Togekiss' "Precious Gift" Ability before or after taking prize cards at the end of my turn?
- {A. Precious Gift is used at the end of your turn after attacking and checking for a KO but before Pokemon Checkup. So if your attack causes a KO you would take Prize cards first, and then you can use Precious Gift.}

POKEMON ATTACKS

JUSTICE KICK (Palafin - SV:Obsidian Flames)

- Q. If I use Palafin's "Justice Kick" attack after I move it up to replace a Pokemon that was KO'd by an opponent's attack, does it do anything?
- {A. No, Palafin was moved to the Active Spot during the opponent's turn, not during "this turn".}

LOUD MIX (Toxtricity - SV:Obsidian Flames)

- Q. Does a Pokemon with multiple types such as Scovillain with the "Double Type" Ability count for two different types of Pokemon for Toxtricity's "Loud Mix" attack?
- {A. Yes, Loud Mix checks for the number of types of Pokemon on your Bench, not how many Pokemon there are.}
- Q. Are colorless Pokemon considered a 'type' in regards to Toxtricity's "Loud Mix" attack?
- A. Yes, Pokemon may be of a "Colorless" type.
